Christ Is Risen, Alleluia! is an Easter anthem. Suggested corresponding lectionary readings include Psalm 118: 14-24, John 20: 1-9, Acts 10: 34-43 and 1 Corinthians 5: 6-8. One basic homiletical theme is spreading the good news: Jesus Christ is risen from the grave!

In rehearsal, strive for a brightly focused sound, especially if brass are used. The optional brass accompaniment may be played by 3 trumpets, trombone and tuba (as written), 3 trumpets only, or 1 trumpet (Trumpet I), depending upon the balance with the choir or the instrumental resources available.
