Book Three of EASY SOLOS FOR SPINET ORGAN is designed as supplementary material for students in PALMER-HUGHES SPINET ORGAN COURSE, Book Three. The fifteen tuneful and familiar melodies in this book, introduce and use in order the seven new upper manual notes taught in the course book. Phrasing, expression and the use of different tempos are emphasized. This gives the student a solid foundation in their ability to play with a musical touch, expression of feeling, and to become familiar with a variety of tempos from slow to very fast.

SUGGESTED REGISTRATION

UPPER MANUAL — Oboe, Saxophone, Trombone, Trumpet, Violin, Cello and a Percussion or Bell sound. (if available)

LOWER MANUAL — Diapason, Strings, Reeds, or Flutes.

PEDAL MANUAL — 8' or 16' pedal or both in combination to properly balance with the volume and character of upper and lower manuals.
