INTRODUCING DOTTED QUARTER NOTES

A dot increases the length of a note by one-half.

$$\text{Dotted Quarter Note} = \text{Quarter Note} + \text{Eighth Note} = 3 \text{ Counts}$$

$$\text{Dotted Half Note} = \text{Half Note} + \text{Quarter Note} = 1\frac{1}{2} \text{ Counts}$$
