

### *Editor's Note*

Franz Joseph Haydn (1732-1809) was one of the most notable composers of the Classic era. Born in Austria, Haydn was an important influence in establishing the classical style in the eighteenth century. He composed numerous instrumental and vocal works in the various forms of his day.

Haydn's extensive background in conducting and composing symphonies is evident in many of his choral works, particularly in his last six masses. For example the "Mass in Time of War," one of his later masses, requires a typical classical orchestra, but without flutes or horns.

For this mass, composed in 1796, Haydn wrote "Missa in tempore belli" (Mass in Time of War) on the score, for he was aware that Napoleon was moving from Italy toward Vienna at that time. The work is also known as the "Paukenmesse" (Drum Mass), because the fanfare-like passage of trumpets and kettle-drums in the beginning of the *Dona nobis pacem* emphasizes the atmosphere of war.

This publication provides the first section of the *Gloria* from that mass. The section has been transposed down a major second from the original. Scored originally for S.A.T.B. voices with an accompaniment of oboes, bassoons, clarinets, timpani, strings and continuo, this new edition includes a keyboard reduction of the instrumental parts as the accompaniment. Dynamic indications, a tempo indication of  $\text{J} = \text{ca. } 128$  and optional English words have also been added by the editor. An edition of this chorus for S.A.T.B. voices is also available (17658).

The very joyful message of the text should be conveyed in performance by a very rhythmic and energized presentation, always emphasizing the normally stressed syllables. Accent marks are indicated over those syllables in the following Latin pronunciation guide.
