



Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Tenor Sax: Most of the G \flat 's in this piece should be played with the alternate fingering.

Clarinet: In the section which starts 4 measures before the end, finger slides are required between C and E \flat .

Hebrew Folk Song

Allegro

- Mellophone (Mlts.):** Melodic line with grace notes, *mf* to *mp*.
- Percussion (Perc.):** Rhythmic accompaniment with snare drum, *mf* to *mp*. Includes a "Sns. off" marking.
