

## CAST OF CHARACTERS AND COSTUMES

SANTA:

Wears traditional Santa suit.

WORKSHOP GANG: ELVES: any number wearing tights and tunics in Christmas colors — 16 have speaking

parts. (Director may wish to double up if necessary.)

REINDEER: any number wearing dark pants or tights under long dark sweatshirts or tunics

with antlers — 8 have speaking parts.

MRS. CLAUS:

Wears bright red or green dress with apron.

ROCK BROCKMAN: News reporter — wears coat and tie/professional dress or suit.

(or ROXIE)

**NEWS STAFF:** 

Optional — people running cameras, lights, holding cue cards, fixing makeup, etc.

CHILDREN:

Any number to sing SANTA, BE GOOD TO ME. Up to 8 optional solos are featured. 4 have

speaking parts. Wear casual clothing in Christmas colors.

**CHORUS:** 

Any number of chorus members may be placed on choral risers upstage, wearing casual

clothing in Christmas colors.

## **SETTING**


**SANTA'S WORKSHOP**: the main setting. Features long tables and/or shelf units with lots of toys and boxes. Some may be wrapped. Chairs and stools may be scattered about to give characters a variety of heights. Choral Risers are placed upstage as needed for additional Chorus.


NOTE: the NEWSROOM/CHILDREN'S ROOM scene may take place in front of the curtain or simply downstage of the workshop.

NEWSROOM: downstage right. A desk and 2 chairs (opt. stools only), the letters WXMAS on a banner or poster behind Rock (Roxie) Brockman. (Opt. — This interview may take place right in Santa's Workshop if desired.)

CHILDREN'S ROOM: simply add chairs, stools, small tables and desks to the downstage area — or children may sit on floor and use lap boards and clipboards. Children may also sit at the edge of the stage. TV (fake or real) is placed downstage left.







MRS. CLAUS: Did anyone find anything else of interest in those 50's boxes?

(Elves may take these items out of boxes and play with them, put them on, etc., as desired. Feel free to substitute other 50's items, adapt script.)

ELF 5: I've got a box of books . . . let's see . . . "Cat in the Hat" by Dr. Seuss. Hey, this is still a

great book! Just read it the other night.

ELF 6: Wow, tons of Silly Putty.

ELF 7: I've got Play-doh in here. I love this stuff!
