Carry Me Home is a transportive arrangement that pairs two traditional spirituals, *Deep River* and *Swing Low, Sweet Chariot*. Available in three voicings for singers of all ages, it is appropriate for performance by both school and church choirs.

Swing Low, Sweet Chariot is considered by some to be the most famous spiritual of all time. Its message is the promise of freedom from life's suffering and pain, and it powerfully conveys the image of a "band of angels" coming to "carry me home" to eternal rest. The text relies upon the biblical reference to the Jordan River, over which the Israelites escaped from Egyptian bondage to Canaan, the "promised land."

Deep River also references both the Jordan River and the promised land and conveys a similar message of hope and peace for the weary traveler along life's journey. Its partnering with **Swing Low**, **Sweet Chariot** is an inspired match.

Carry Me Home is appropriate for school concerts in the spring or for special occasions celebrating American and African-American heritage. It is also appropriate for church choirs throughout the year, and especially for All Saints', funerals and memorial services, Lent and Transfiguration. Suggested corresponding lectionary readings include 2 Kings 2: 1-12a Psalms 46 and 50, Mark 9: 2-9 and 10: 17-30, and Hebrews 4: 1-13.
