Finding the Costumes

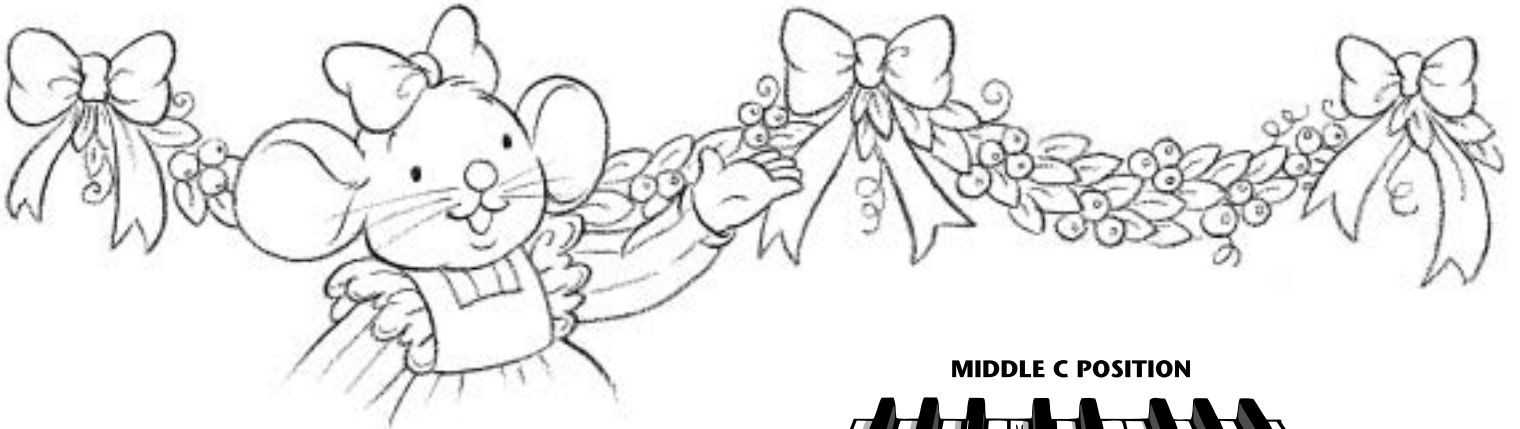
Help the Music Friends find their costumes for the Christmas Pageant.

- 2 Then color the picture.

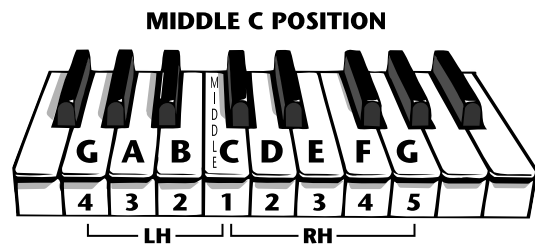
