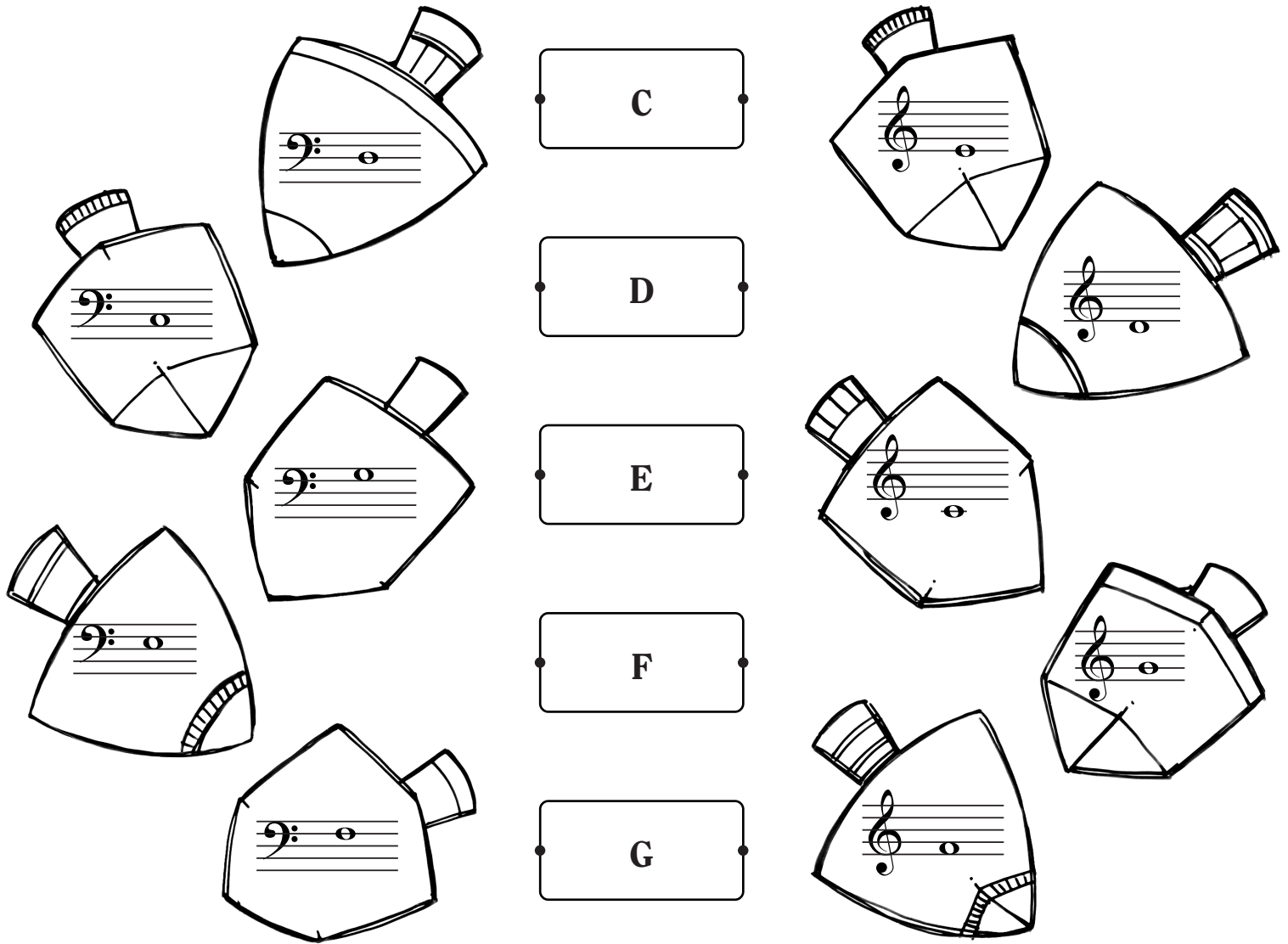


## Matching Dreydls
