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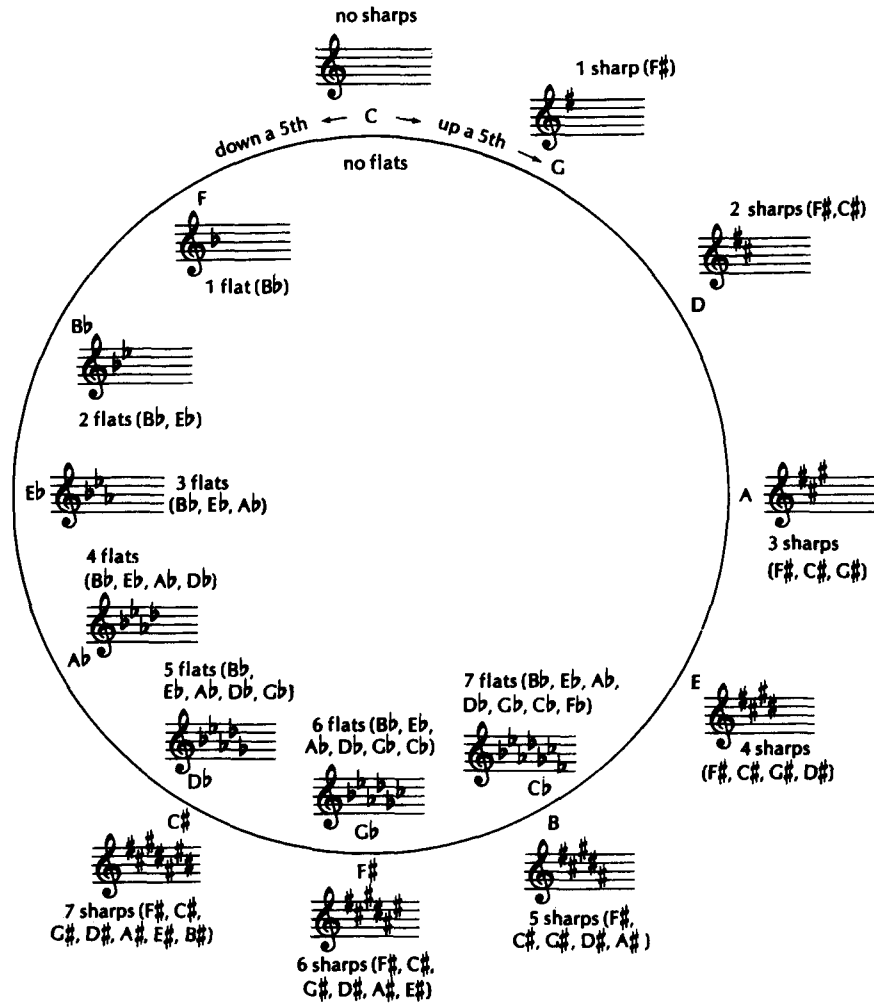

CIRCLE OF FIFTHS

ALL MAJOR KEYS

If we put the sharp keys and the flat keys together, the circle would look like this:



The following keys are enharmonic equivalents: Db & C#, Gb & F#, Cb & B.
They sound the same but are spelled differently.
