Summerset March is a moderate-tempo march written in cut time. To help achieve the proper style, staccatos should be played with a light tongue and quarter notes that are not slurred should be played with a slight separation. It is also helpful to think of the accented notes as being played "stronger" rather than "heavier" or "louder" than non-accented notes. Careful attention should be given to dynamic changes, including the *subito pianos* beginning at measure [101].
