Flourish and Festivity was composed to celebrate the remarkable careers of two gifted music educators, Ronald Case and Robert Lehner of Clarence, New York. To further emphasize the jubilant tone of the piece, the entire work should be performed with energy and excitement. Pay careful attention to articulations in the opening *Maestoso* along with the driving eighth notes in the *Energico* section to heighten the dramatic effect of the piece. The sudden change from *ff* to *mp* at measure 107, combined with the gradual return to *ff* in the measures that follow, make for an exciting finish.
