A Round of Thanks is a delightful choral adaptation of the beloved traditional folk tune, *O Waly Waly*, which is popularly known as *The Water Is Wide*. In this setting, the arranger has paired the tune with an adaptation of Henry Alford's historic hymn text, *Come*, *Ye Thankful People*, *Come* (1844).

This 2-part any combination voicing may be performed by both treble and mixed voices, as follows:

TrebleMixedPart I – SopranoPart I – WomenORSopranos & TenorsPart II – AltoPart II – MenORAltos & Basses

Appropriate for performance throughout the year, A Round of Thanks may be especially useful for harvest celebrations, Thanksgiving and Christ the King. Suggested corresponding scripture readings include Psalm 95, Matthew 9: 35-38, Mark 4: 26-32, Philippians 4: 4-7 and Revelation 14: 14-16. One basic homiletical theme is rejoicing in God's abundant goodness through prayer, praise and songs of thanksgiving.
