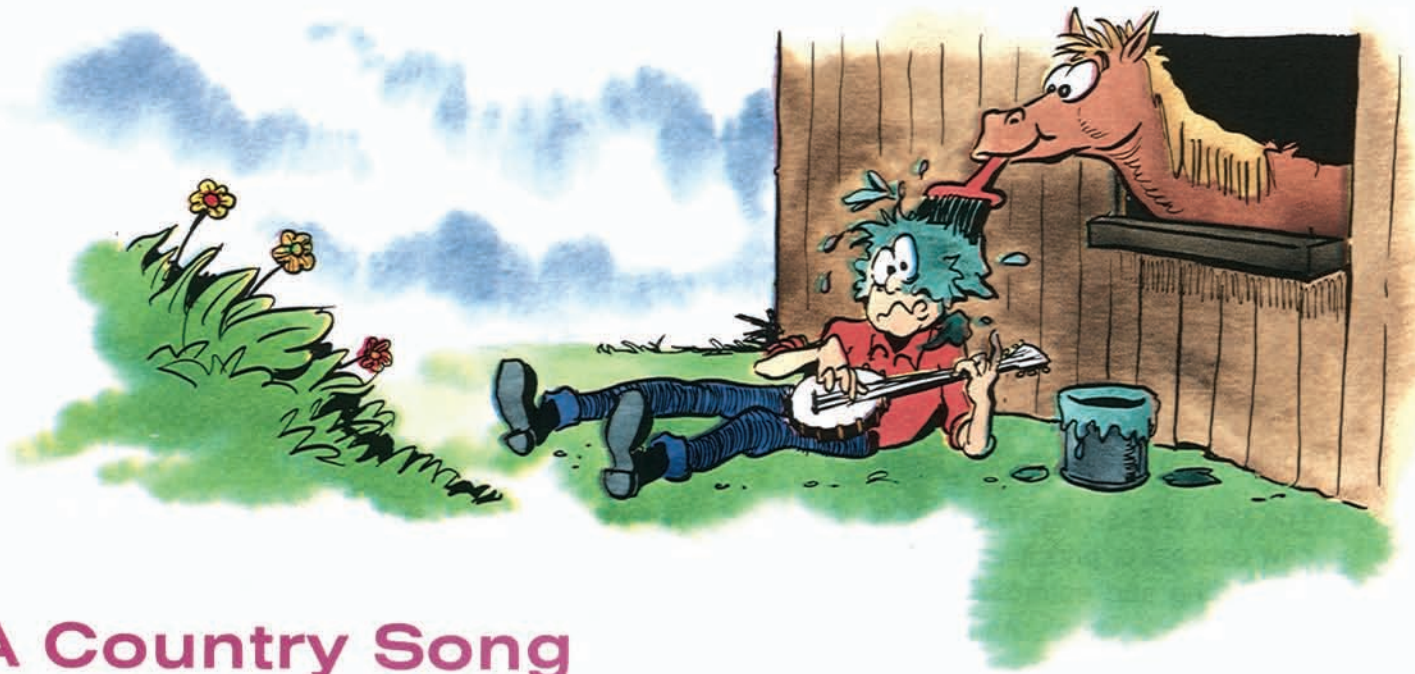
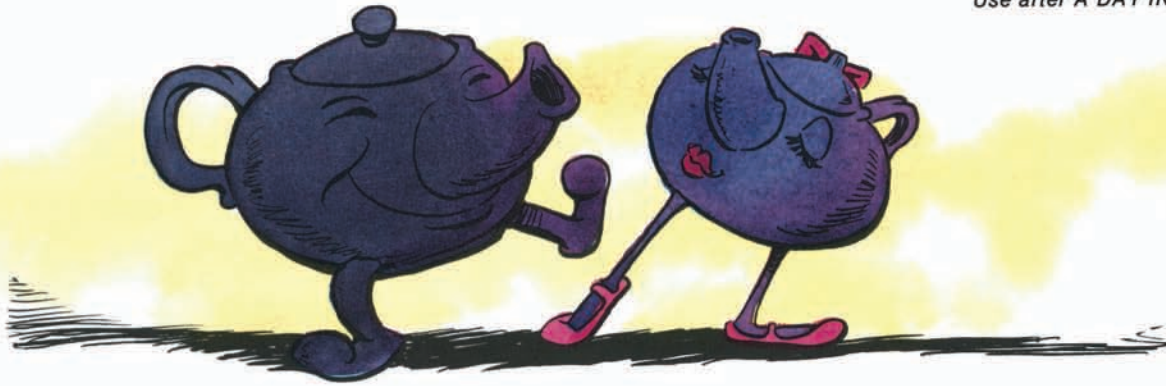

The GAVOTTE is a famous old French dance in $\frac{4}{4}$ time, beginning always on the 3rd beat of the measure. It originated with alpine mountain people who called themselves "Gavots."

This gavotte is based on the old American folk song *I'M A LITTLE TEAPOT*.

Allegro moderato
