**Foreword**

LET'S HAVE A MUSICAL RHYTHM BAND combines rhythm instruments with the music of the masters and proves that learning rhythms can be fun. Each selection contains a short biographical sketch of the composer and pertinent musical facts. Rhythm drills which prepare for each piece and musical terms and definitions are also included. Each piece should be prepared by first learning the Rhythm Key (chanting the rhythm with syllables), and then

practicing the exercises marked "Rhythm Practice."

It is most important to make the children aware that there is much more to making music than just learning and playing notes. It is the author's belief that properly using the material in this book will help change the usual connotation connected with the words "rhythm band" and will lead towards the goal of having a MUSICAL RHYTHM BAND!
