After Jesus spoke these words, He looked up to heaven and said, "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, so that Your Son may glorify You, as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to all whom You have given Him. And this is eternal life, that they may know You the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."

The Blessing Riddle poignantly combines a traditional folk melody commonly known as *The Riddle Song* with new lyrics that convey the promise of Christ's peace. An alternate benediction text is provided on the reproducible songsheet for choir and/or congregation (please see page 11). Suitable for worship throughout the year, **The Blessing Riddle** may be especially appropriate for Eastertide or Ascension, graduation, fare yell services and funerals.

Suggested corresponding scripture readings include Psalm 67, Matthew 19.16.29, John 14.25.31 & 17: 1-5, and 1 John 5: 1-13. One basic homiletical theme is the promise of peace and eternal life for all true believers.
