SCENE 1: SPACE

(Music begins. Lights up. The Sun, wearing a straw hat, sunglasses, and fanny pack, is downstage center looking at a vacation brochure. After reading it, he/she stretches, puts the brochure in fanny pack, picks up the suitcase and exits stage L.)

1. PROLOGUE

SCENE 2: MILKY WAY GALAXY

(Lights on, dim setting. All planets except Pluto spin to center stage from all directions.)

(scream as they collide) Ah!

(The following lines are said one right after another.)

MERCURY:	Watch where you're going!
Venus:	Where am I?
Earth:	What's going on?
Mars:	I can't see!
Jupiter:	Yikes!
SATURN:	I'm lost!
Uranus:	Help!
Neptune:	Ouch!
Earth:	(raises hands) Silence, everyone! (Planets stop talking. Venus raises hand. Earth points to him/her.) You, there. Who are you and what are you doing?
Venus:	(clears throat) Well, I was minding my own business spinning in my orbit when all of a sud- den everything went dark! (others agree) I totally spaced out and that's when I spun into all of you.
Mercury:	(looking around) Hey, my sun's missing! (other planets look around)
Mars:	So is mine. (others agree)
Jupiter:	And I've lost my moons!
SATURN:	You mean we've all lost our sun AND our moons? (Planets all begin to sob.)

PLANETS:

Earth:	Please! We really do need to maintain some kind of universal order here.
Uranus:	But who are we?
Earth:	It seems we are all planets from the same solar system.
Mercury:	What does that mean?
Earth:	It means we <i>all</i> share the same sun.
Venus:	We do?
Earth:	At least, we did. It seems to have disappeared.
Mars:	What are we going to do?
Earth:	We'll have to find it. In the meantime, let's not panic.
Jupiter:	You're right. Let's look on the bright side. (other planets moan)
Neptune:	Poor choice of words.
Earth:	Jupiter's got a point. After all, we're still in one piece. Besides, I've always wanted to meet all of you.
Planets:	(over music intro) Me, too! Yeah! This is great! etc. (Planets form line facing audience in random order.)
