
Mozart Mouse Rhythm

Meet Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart

Mozart Mouse was named for Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756–1791), a famous composer from Austria. Wolfgang was so talented that his father quit his job to educate the young boy and travel with him to play recitals. He began to write music at age 5. He wrote his first symphony when he was 9 and his first opera when he was 12. During his life, Mozart wrote over 600 pieces of music.

Meet Mozart Mouse

Mozart Mouse is a tiny gray mouse who lives in a big house with two children and lots of toys. Mozart Mouse explores the children's Music Room with his friend Beethoven Bear.
