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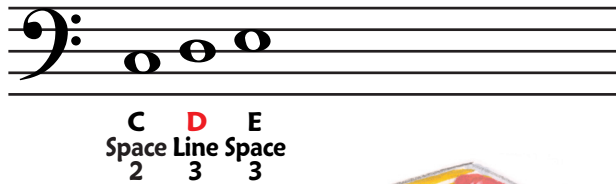
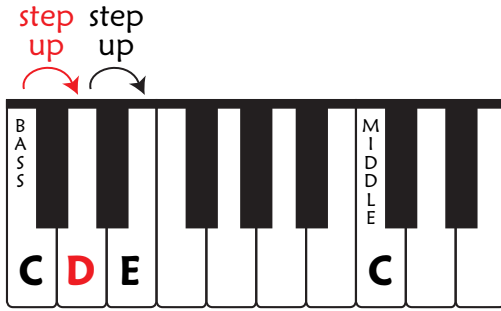


New Note D

A step up from Bass C is D.
A step up from D is E.

Starting with Bass C, point to the notes on the staff as you say, "space-line-space, C-D-E."
