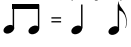


# On Boynton Avenue

# Niagara

Niagara Falls is the largest waterfall in North America, and the second largest in the world. Nearly one fifth of all the fresh water in the world eventually tumbles over the falls, at a rate of about 40 million gallons per minute! The crashing of the falling water results in a large, permanent mist cloud and a continuous roar of sound!

Moderately (♩ = ca. 112) Majestic (♩ = 92)

The score is written for piano and bass. It begins with a *mf* dynamic and a tempo of *Moderately* (♩ = ca. 112). The first system (measures 1-3) features a melodic line in the right hand with fingerings 2, 4, 1, 3, 1 and a bass line with chords and fingerings 2/3, 1/3, 1/2/3.
