## THE LEGEND OF DUFFY'S CUT

This medley of original tunes set in a traditional-sounding Irish style tells the mysterious story of the fate of a group of Irish-immigrant railroad workers. *The Legend of Duffy's Cut* is a storytelling piece that follows the group to America and observes both their work to build the railroads that drove our country's expansion and their deaths under suspicious circumstances. To this day, there are reports of mysterious happenings at the site of the deaths, now known as "Duffy's Cut." From the sad and mournful "Duffy's Lament" to the high-energy "McCarrick's Jig," this piece is a real student and audience pleaser. In Bob Phillips's signature style, all sections have an opportunity to play the melody.

**Program Notes:** The Legend of Duffy's Cut

In the year 2000, at a site called Duffy's Cut outside Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, several seemingly supernatural occurrences prompted an investigation led by several professors from Immaculate College. Dr. William Watson headed the archeological dig and uncovered the following story, 168 years after it happened:

In 1832, the Pennsylvania Railroad reported the deaths of 57 Irish-immigrant workers due to cholera. As a result, the location where the deaths occurred was named after Mr. Duffy, the Irish foreman who had hired the railroad workers. After studying a multitude of reported ghost sightings, Dr. Watson concluded that the men had died under mysterious circumstances, thus leading to the inexplicable disturbances. His theory is that anti-Irish vigilantes murdered the 57 workers, since such groups were prevalent during the 1830s. The investigation also concludes that there was a cover-up of the incident. Currently, researchers are trying to locate descendents of the workers in Ireland. This piece pays tribute to the men who died and to the "Legend of Duffy's Cut."
