

FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF FLASHCARDS.

Cards are numbered at the bottom, in order of introduction in the LESSON BOOKS. Cards are numbered consecutively from Lesson Book 1A (1) through Lesson Book 3 (205).

Page numbers corresponding to Lesson Book pages are given in the UPPER LEFT CORNER of each card. As these pages are studied in the Lesson Books, pull out the appropriate cards. Cards may be kept on a 1½" loose leaf ring, hung on a hook, or held together with a rubber band, to use for drill and review.

Emphasize drill on NEW CARDS. Review old cards every few weeks.

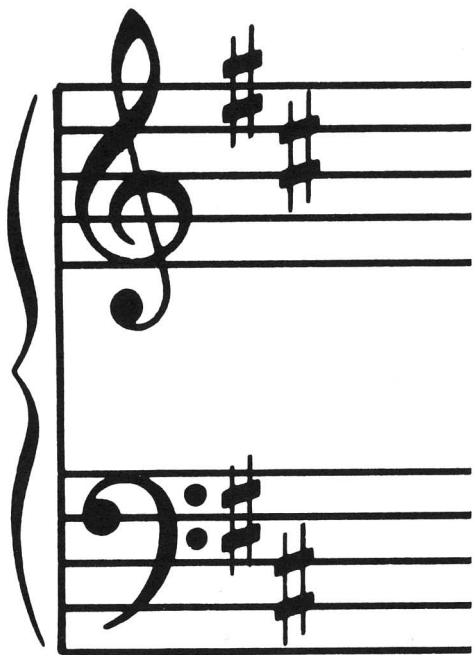
Answers on the backs of cards are easily understood by anyone, whether or not they have had musical training. Students may be given flash card drills at home by friends and family members.
