

The park is divided between North Carolina and Tennessee. Elevations in the park range from 875 feet to over 6,000 feet above sea level. Sixteen mountain peaks are more than 6,000 feet. The highest of these is Clingmans Dome, which soars 6,643 feet above southeastern Tennessee.

The highest elevations of the Appalachian Trail are on the 70 miles that run through the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. Clingmans Dome is the highest point on the entire trail. The path through the Smokies also has the most rainfall and snowfall on the southern section of the trail.
