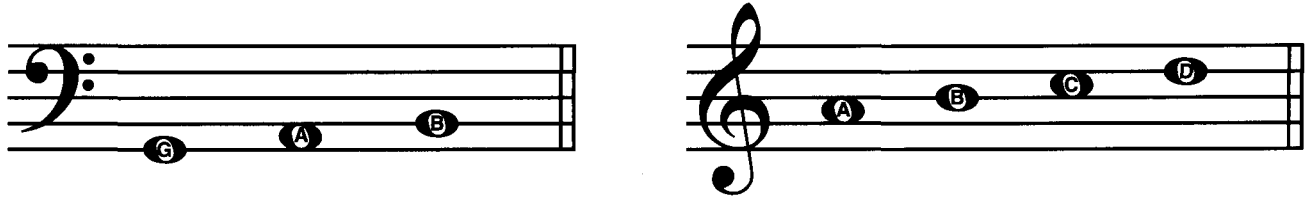

## About the DVD

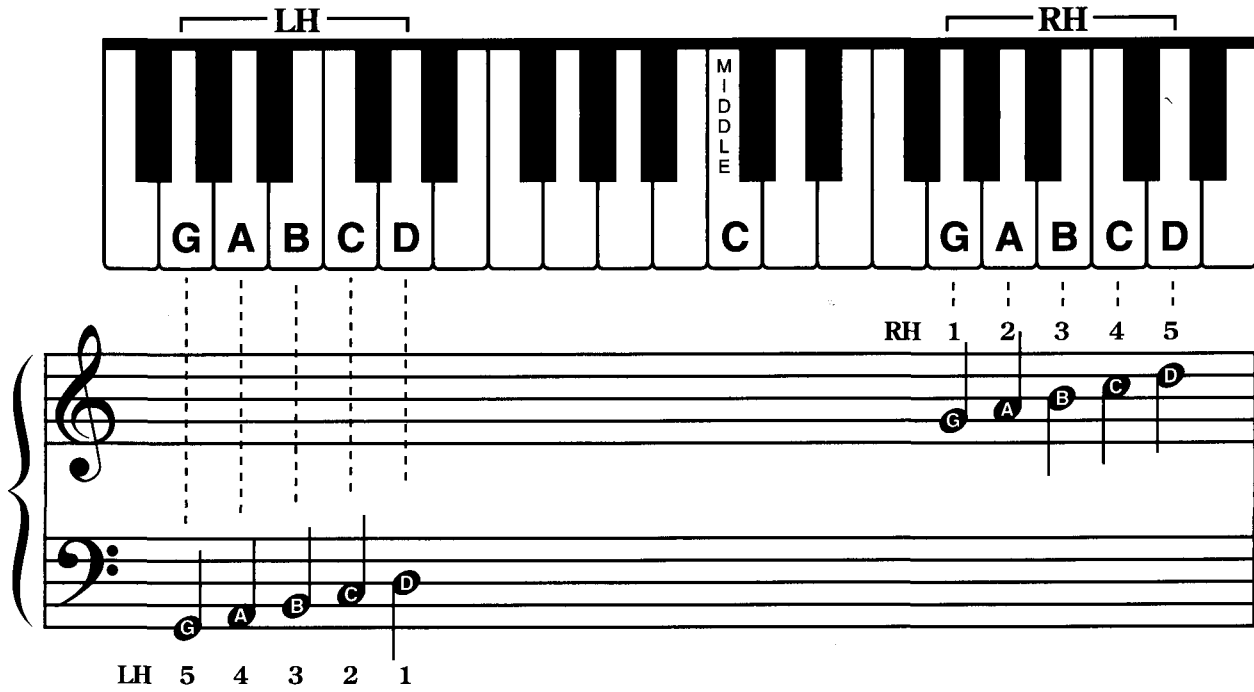
