
Naming the Keys


The MUSICAL ALPHABET has 7 letters: A B C D E F G

1. Write the MUSICAL ALPHABET in the squares on this keyboard. Begin with A.




Each white key is recognized by its position in or next to a black key group.

To learn the names of the white keys, it is best to practice naming them in a random order, instead of counting up the keyboard alphabetically. When each white key can be quickly recognized by its position in relation to the black keys, you will always know exactly which key you are playing.



C is on the LEFT of any 2 black-key group!


2. Find all the C's on this keyboard. Print a C on each one.






E is on the RIGHT of any 2 black-key group!

3. Find all the E's on this keyboard. Print an E on each one.






