This original composition is characterized by mysterious melodic themes intertwined with exciting and bold flashes of sound. It is based on a wildlife research study that took place in Malaysia's largest national park, the Taman Negara. Researchers embarked on an expedition in the jungle tracking one of the wildest of wild animals; the tiger. Despite spending nearly three years in the rainforest, the researchers never saw a single tiger. Thus, the elusive creatures earned their reputations as "ghosts." Composer Victor Lopez takes you on a musical expedition that emulates the experience of the research team. An embracing and emotional addition to the string repertoire!
