PROGRAM NOTES

THE GOLDEN VANITY (a march for military band) was begun by Ralph Vaughan Williams in 1933 and remained uncompleted at his death. The two pages of the full score that are currently part of the manuscripts catalogue at the British Library (57288) show the following instrumentation:

Flute and Piccolo in C, Solo B♭ Clarinet, B♭ Clarinets 1 and 2, E♭ Alto Saxophone, B♭ Tenor Saxophone, Bassoon, Solo B♭ Cornet, B♭ Cornets 1, 2 and 3, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba and Percussion (Snare Drum, Bass Drum and Crash Cymbals)

In setting out to complete this work in the style of Ralph Vaughan Williams' other march forms, two additional folksongs with similar themes were utilized. Both tunes also exist in arrangements by the composer for voices and piano. "The Arethusa" is heard in the second strain, with "Just As The Tide Was Flowing" forming the Trio.

I wish to extend my deep gratitude to Ursula Vaughan Williams for granting her kind permission to complete this work, and to Mr. Hugh Cobbe, director of RVW Ltd, for his helpful assistance in facilitating the initial request.

The premiere performance of this march was given by the Purdue University Symphonic Band and was conducted by Jay S. Gephart.


