4 Circle the Nannerl Mouse rhythm pattern each time it appears in the music on page 3.

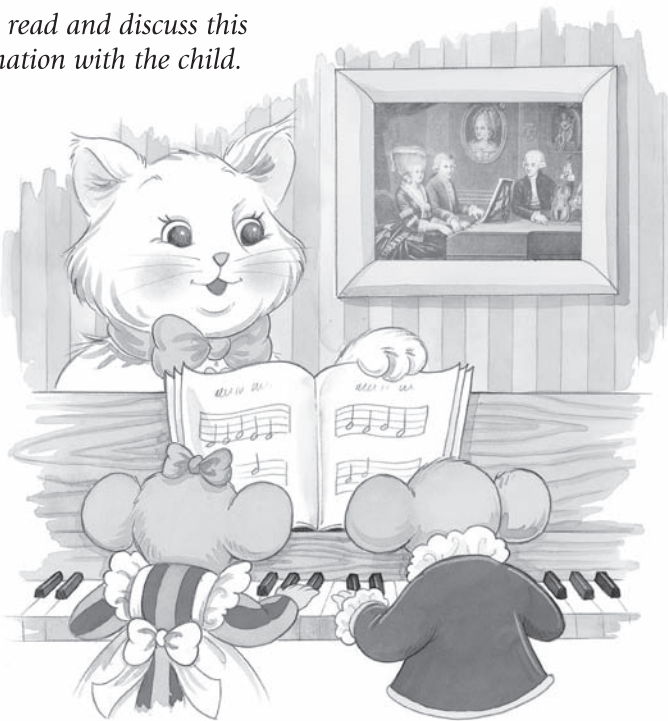


Say: Nan - ne - rl Mouse

Meet Nannerl Mozart

Maria Anna “Nannerl” Mozart (1751–1829) was the older sister of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756–1791). She first studied music with her father when she was seven years old. She was an extremely gifted musician and toured Munich, Vienna, London and Paris performing with her brother. She did compose some music, but none of it survives. A wife and mother of three children, she also was a well-respected piano teacher in Salzburg and St. Gilgen.
