

Lesson Assignment Pages

- 3. **Daily Practice Time:** Spaces are provided for the student to record daily practice time in minutes as well as the total time practiced during the week.
- 4. **Notepad to Parents from Teacher:** This space allows the teacher to make specific suggestions related to using the Flash Cards and CD recordings at home. Additional space is provided for the teacher to

- communicate with parents regarding other aspects of study.
- 5. Notepad to Teacher from Parents: This space allows parents to keep the teacher informed about practice during the week. Such communication can be a useful aid in helping the teacher structure the next lesson for maximum effectiveness.
