NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Perfect for learning to play in parts, this wonderfully simple yet interesting beginning tune is in D Major. While remaining in first position, students will practice playing in steps and intervals with string crossings. The theme is written to include the intervals of M2, M3, P4 and P5, building from smallest interval to largest. This gives students practice in playing both steps and skips, and also requires string crossings. Rhythms alternate between quarter notes and half notes, with the low strings frequently in contrast to the high strings. This is an excellent piece to teach dynamic contrast. There are several crescendes and diminuendos, and several subito dynamic contrasts near the end of the piece.

NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
