NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Built from primitive sounding rhythms and modal harmonies, this intriguing work opens with an ominous introduction that leads into the first statement of the main theme. *Primitivo* is correlated to *Orchestra Expressions* Book I, or to most first year string method books. It is scored for three parts—Ist Violins, 2nd Violins/Violas and Cello/Bass. Please note that the Piano part is completely optional—the piece will sound complete and full with or without it. Care should be given to ensure that there is a good balance between the upper two voices in the counterpoint sections beginning at measures I7 and 41. I hope you and your string orchestra find *Primitivo* to be a fun and worthwhile experience!

NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
