PROGRAM NOTES

Coventry Carol was composed sometime in the 15th or 16th century during the period of Renaissance, and was named after the city of Coventry, England. The lyrics, as depicted in *The Pageant of the Shearmen and the Tailors*, depicts Herod's slaughter of the innocent.

Lully, Lullay, Thou tiny little Child,

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This setting is based in C minor and may introduce the concert pitch accidentals A \flat and B (natural) to your beginning students. The tempo marked is for reference only; the director may choose another tempo more suited for the ensemble. Take care in noting all slurs and articulations throughout the piece. Be sure that the students do not slur all notes together; that is, that they rearticulate where notated. The last five bars are should be played rubato.

It is my hope that this arrangement suites your holiday performance needs while providing reinforcement of important musical concepts.
