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The *Belwin Beginning Band Kit #5*, for beginning concert band, contains four grade-one works in a single publication. It can be used as a program for a complete concert, or as supplemental material for the beginning band. Each of the selections is written in a different musical style and will give variety to the concert in addition to broadening the learning experience of the students.

I. THE BLUE DANUBE WALTZ

PROGRAM NOTES

Johann Strauss II (1825–1899) was commonly known as “the Waltz King.” He was born into a musical family and wrote operettas and marches as well as waltzes. He is best known for revolutionizing the musical form, the waltz, from a peasant dance to stately entertainment. *The Blue Danube* was written in 1867.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Feel free to adjust the dynamics and tempo to accommodate the abilities of the ensemble. The waltz style is generally performed in one pulse per measure, but for younger performers, the tempo should be paced in a pattern of three. The bass line (Tuba, etc. along with percussion) will help keep the basic waltz feeling with a strong pulse on the first beat of the measure.

II. ALOUETTE

PROGRAM NOTES

One of the most popular of French folk songs, *Alouette* is presented by the band in a “question and answer” format—Woodwinds verses Brass. Of course, the percussion section helps both groups out to a big finish.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Try to keep the balance between the play of the woodwinds and brass sections throughout. You may have to adjust printed volume levels to do this. Most importantly...have fun with this arrangement!

III. TRUMPETS, FRONT AND CENTER (Theme and Variations)

PROGRAM NOTES

The trumpet, with all of its relations (cornet, flugelhorn, bugle), is one of the most popular of musical instruments. It has a place in most musical organizations, such as orchestras, jazz and swing dance bands, and, of course, concert bands. Theme and Variation selections are common in the musical repertoire written for the trumpet, and this introduction to the musical form sends the trumpeters on their way.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Of course, balance is the primary factor in this selection once the “fingers and notes” are in place with the trumpet section. Keep the trumpet section foremost and in the spotlight. Feel free to adjust the tempo so that every trumpeter will have success with their performance.

IV. PARAMOUNT MARCH

PROGRAM NOTES

The musical style named the “march” indicates a spirited composition performed by an organization in a seated position or in a moving formation such as a parade. This piece, *Paramount March*, is written to project the spirit of young bandspeople the world over who study and perform compositions such as this.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

You may adjust the tempo to fit the needs of the ensemble, but keep an even tempo throughout. Likewise, the dynamic levels may be adjusted to balance the ensemble sound. Remember—spirited and loud are two different qualities.
