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PROGRAM NOTES

Here is a suite for young concert band of three pieces about "Buffalo" in three distinctive styles. The first, "Buffalo Gals," is a moderately fast folk song written for stage shows in the middle of the 19th century. The second, "Home on the Range," is a slow ballad about the range where the animals lived. The third, "Shuffle Off To Buffalo," is a swing-type show tune written in the early part of the 20th century for the film, *42nd Street*. Each of the selections are complete by themselves which indicates that they can be performed one after the other as a suite, or independently by themselves.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

1. Buffalo Gals

This folk song should be performed with spirit, mimicking the original style that was used in the early performances of the stage shows. The articulation is carefully marked and attention to this musical quality will help create the necessary style.

The sixteenth notes at measure 25 should be played in this same short crisp style as well even though they are not marked staccato. Feel free to adjust the volume levels for good ensemble balance, and the tempo to the ability level of the ensemble.

2. Home on the Range

This pretty ballad is arranged as a brass instrument solo with band accompaniment. Solo parts are included for Trumpet (or Baritone T.C.), French Horn, Trombone or Baritone, and Tuba, and are available for related "World Parts" on our website at alfred.com/worldparts. Feature your best brass performer, and don't overlook the Tuba as a soloist. The solo is written in the beautiful middle register.

The accompaniment part is melodic and written to accompany the soloist. Be sure that the soloist is the featured performer. If you don't have a student who can perform the solo, consider an adult, possibly a music teacher associate who was a brass major in college or a musical citizen of the community.

3. Shuffle Off To Buffalo

The style is important in this piece. The swing style with the triplet eighth note feel is essential, as this song was written at the time when swing eighth notes were introduced in popular music. It is a good teaching tool also, contrasting the even eighth notes in "Buffalo Gals" with the swing eighth notes of this piece. Practice this before the first reading of the arrangement.

Suggestion: Draw eight eighth notes on a chalkboard. Then, using the tuning note of the instruments or middle range concert pitch F, have the students play the rhythm pattern at first even and then in a swing style. Then have them perform one style right after the other, repeating the rhythm pattern to perform the difference. It should be fun to do and a good learning experience for the students.


