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PROGRAM NOTES

The American Road was commissioned by The Association of Concert Bands. This new work by Jerry Brubaker is a musical excursion into the American driving experience. The piece has subtitles for each section. Most need no explanation.

"Call of the open road"

"Wide open spaces" — Imagine the grandeur of a road where you can see for miles.

"Purple Mountain Majesty" — Inspired by Trail Ridge Pass in Colorado

"Morning Rush Hour" — The joy of the daily commute into the city

"The Expressway"

"Gridlock" — Suddenly all traffic stops and in the distance you hear the chiming of the clock tower telling you that you are late for work.

"Covered Bridges" — Seek out one of America's treasured covered bridges and you are bound to find yourself on a picturesque country road that will take you back to a simpler time.

"Our Favorite Road" — This can be the road to the beach or the mountains or just cruisin' on a sunny day with the top down!

The composer hopes that this piece makes you want to pack up the car and see the USA!

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Make the opening fanfare big as it sets the tone for the piece and says to the audience "See the USA."

The triangle solo at measure 34 is an alarm clock. It must be prominent.

The walking bass in the bass instruments beginning at measure 39 is doubled so players may strategically "lay out" as necessary for breath. It will help to have an acoustic or electric bass on this part.

Care must be taken in the entire rush hour section for proper balance of instruments. Some of the sonorities are dissonant by design. Proper intonation is important so as not to further increase this dissonance.

The woodblock statement beginning at measure 121 can be played on temple blocks and use additional pitches ad lib, but tastefully.

The synthesizer part beginning at measure 157 employs a synth bass to support the bass line to the orchestration. It is optional but recommended. Although it is not on the score, the pitches duplicate the bass line. Patch is General MIDI #88 Lead 8 (Bass+Lead).
