Staccato

- Your teacher will play STACCATO and LEGATO melodies.
 - Circle the S if the melody is STACCATO.
 - Circle the L if the melody is LEGATO.
- Your teacher will play four melodies. Add a STACCATO DOT to each staccato note.
 - If the note stem points DOWN, put the dot OVER the note.
 - If the stem points UP, put the dot UNDER the note.






