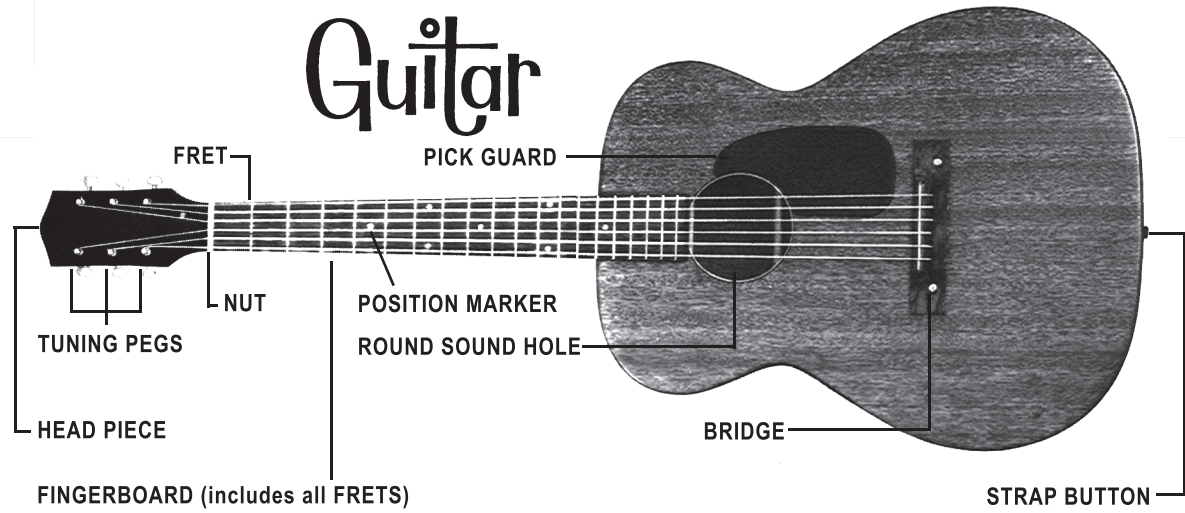
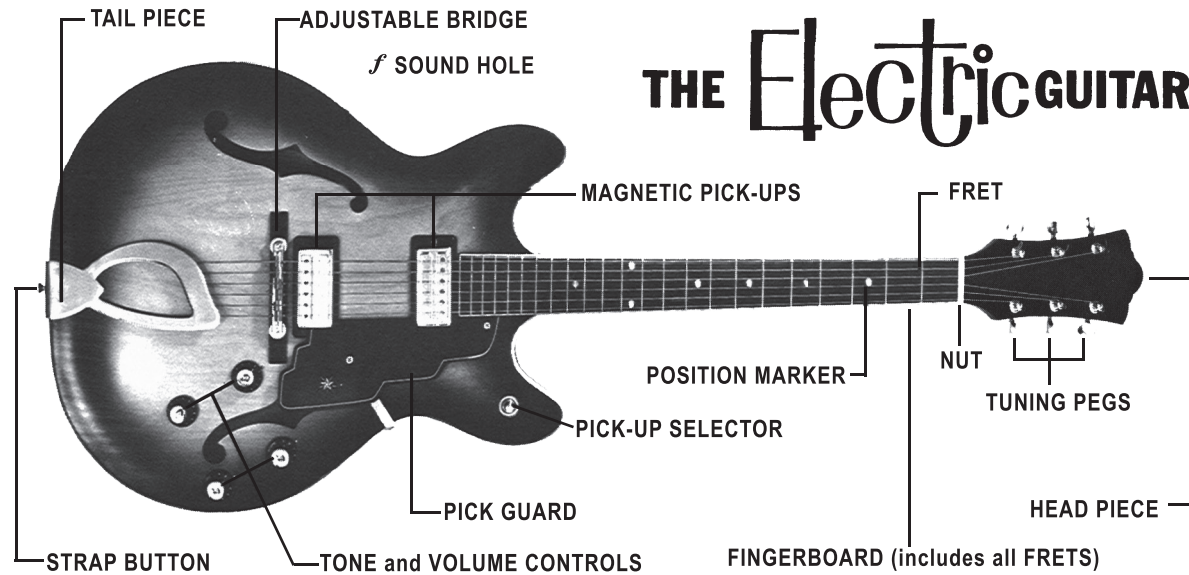


THE ROUND SOUND HOLE OR FLAT TOP

the guitar parts

The guitar is strummed with the right hand. You may use a guitar pick or your thumb. The pick is held loosely between the thumb and 1st finger. Strum all notes and chords in a downward motion unless otherwise indicated.

Sound-Off: HOW TO COUNT TIME

TIME SIGNATURES

Each piece of music has numbers at the beginning called a time signature. These numbers tell us how to count time.

THE TOP NUMBER tells us how many counts in each measure.

THE BOTTOM NUMBER tells us what kind of note gets one count.

4 KINDS OF NOTES

QUARTER NOTE
ONE COUNT

HALF NOTE
TWO COUNTS

DOTTED HALF NOTE
THREE COUNTS

WHOLE NOTE
FOUR COUNTS
