Boogie Blues Track 17

Boogie is a style of rock music based on the blues. It is characterized by a repetitive bass figure. Before playing along with the CD, practice this song alone until you are comfortable with it. You may make up your own fills or use any of the previous fills you've learned.

* For songs with more than two endings, the number in the first bracket tells you how many times to go back to the beginning before moving on to the second bracket in order to finish the song.

Alternate Hi-Hat Sound:

Go back and play *Boogie Blues* with the hi-hat cymbals partially closed (cymbals lightly touching). This will provide a looser, "swishing" sound.
