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PROGRAM NOTES

The Finnish composer, Jean Sibelius, lived for 91 years from 1865 to 1957. During his life he composed many works, including seven symphonies, but is best known for his violin concerto (1903–1905), *Valse Triste* (1904) and *Finlandia* (1898). He wrote in the late Romantic period and his music played an important role in the formation of the Finnish national identity.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

As this is the main theme without any development, keep the tempo steady and moderately slow in a flowing approach. For young beginning musicians, the quarter rest at the beginning of the measure may bring a counting problem. It is advisable to practice this rhythm pattern with the ensemble before sight-reading the arrangement.

NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
