Greenwillow Portrait is a lyric work in the British folk-song style. Care should be taken to maintain a smooth, flowing quality throughout (never hurried). At measure $\boxed{27}$, the trumpets and upper woodwinds should play legato, with the low brass and woodwinds slightly marcato for contrast. At measure $\boxed{35}$, care should be taken so that the background does not overshadow the melody in the 1st alto sax and oboe. The crescendo starting at measure $\boxed{43}$ should be gradual. The final chord in the trombones and baritones should release cleanly with the staccato eighth note in the bass instruments and timpani.
