## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This is a great tune with a new twist. In addition to featuring your vocalist, the chart has plenty of excitement in the band as well. Observe dynamics and strive for a full sound, but be careful not to overpower the vocalist. The band can blow out at measures 69–76 where the vocalist rests, then resume an accompaniment volume when the vocalist returns at 77. The dynamic peak is at measures 96 and 97. One interesting feature of this song is the 5-bar phrase that occurs each time on the verse. A closer look reveals the 5-bar phrase is divided  $\frac{5}{2}$ , which is slightly out of the ordinary  $\frac{6}{2}$  typically heard in a pop tune.

### The Rhythm Section

Play the chart with a straight-eighth feel and keep a relaxed groove.

*Guitar:* The guitar is really the engine driving the rhythm section on this arrangement, so listen to the other rhythm players and find the groove and lock-in with the drums. Use an acoustic sound, play full-strum throughout and note the “choked” notes of the pattern. Choked refers to muting the chord after playing it. Continue this pattern where marked Simile. As always, blend with the ensemble.

*Piano:* Bring out the solo line at measure 77, joined by unison saxes 4 measures later.

*Bass (electric if possible):* Play with punch but always blend, and avoid overpowering the band. The line at measure 51 is in unison with the bari sax and left-hand piano—listen to each other.

*Drums:* Play the simple rhumba pattern as written with attention to dynamics. Listen and lock in with the guitar throughout.

### The Horn Section

There is plenty of section unison in this chart. After becoming familiar with the chart, the lead trumpet could choose to lay out of some unison lines to prepare for certain high passages if needed. Listen carefully to each other to achieve accurate intonation. While observing dynamics, strive for full sound, being careful to not overpower the vocalist even though some figures are marked  $\frac{1}{2}$ . Horns can step up to shine in the intro, the ending and at measure 69. Carefully observe articulations—staccato notes are short but not clipped; rooftop accents ( $\wedge$ ) are detached—think “daht.” Note that the brass have a flip or quick turn at measure 96—rehearse this figure so the entire section plays it together to follow the lead trumpet.

### Vocal Soloist

The solo vocal range is from low F below middle C to fourth line D with some cued notes provided for alternate choices at the highest points of the melody. The written melody should be studied carefully and practiced with the piano player first to become comfortable with the melody. The section at measure 100 is played three times; the vocalist may feel free to “ad lib” or take liberties with the melody the 2nd and 3rd times if desired.
