


Jimmy Page is the guitarist, co-songwriter, and producer for Led Zeppelin. His heavy riffs, wild solos, and intense stage presence helped define what it means to be a rock guitarist. His guitar solo on "Stairway to Heaven" was voted the "greatest guitar solo of all time" by *Guitar World* magazine. He combined his roots in the blues with other influences, such as folk, funk, and Middle Eastern music, to create his own distinct hard-rock style.








\*Depress both the 1st and 2nd strings at the 1st fret with your first finger.











## INTRODUCING TRIPLETS Track 52




When three notes are grouped together with the figure "3" above or below the notes, the group is called a TRIPLET. The rhythmic value of the triplet is equal to the value given to two of the same kind of note. In  $\frac{3}{4}$  or  $\frac{4}{4}$  time, two eighth notes get one count, so an eighth note triplet will also get one count.

In the following exercise, play the three notes of each triplet in one count.
