## Staccato against Legato



**Technique Tip:** Stay close to the keys when playing *staccato* notes.



## **Open the Hand**



**Technique Tip:** Gently transfer your arm and finger weight from key to key as you open your hand.



## **Speed Links**



**Technique Tip:** Drop on the first note of each measure with *arm weight*.



#### Rock the Alberti Bass



**Technique Tip:** Use Gentle Hand Rocks as you play from note to note.



## Playing In and Out of Black Keys



**Technique Tip:** Move the hand slightly "in" to play chords with black keys.








#### Music with Action
