### PROGRAM NOTES

The tune was written around 1856 by William Steffe. The first known lyrics were called "Canaan's Happy Shore" or "Brothers, Will You Meet Me?" and the song was sung as a campfire spiritual. Julia Ward Howe wrote the current words to the song as "Battle Hymn of the Republic" in 1861, and it became popular during the American Civil War. Since that time it has become an extremely popular and well-known American patriotic song.

### NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

The flams in the snare drum should be addressed before the first rehearsal. If the student is not ready for this rudiment, it may be omitted.

Also, if the roll(s) in the snare drum cannot be accomplished smoothly, they may be changed to repeated eighths or sixteenths. The roll is certainly preferred, however.
