NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Treat your orchestra to one of the great American standards, perfectly arranged for middle school and high school strings! Written in 1951, "When I Fall in Love" made its debut in the 1952 film, *One Minute to Zero*, and has subsequently been performed and recorded extensively, with its latest resurgence in the 1993 film, *Sleepless in Seattle*. This piece should be played expressively, making it a great teaching piece. Liberties may be taken with ritardandos and other elements. The altered harmonies also require a careful ear, particularly in the chromatic inner lines.

NOTE FROM THE EDITOR

All Belwin string parts have been carefully bowed and fingered appropriately by level. The Yellow Very Beginning series includes many bowings as well as reminder fingerings for first-time readers. The Red Beginning series includes frequent bowings to assist younger players. Fingerings for altered pitches are often marked. The Green Intermediate series includes appropriately placed bowings for middle-level students. Fingerings and positions are marked for notes beyond first position. The Blue Concert series includes bowings appropriate for the experienced high school player. Fingerings and position markings are indicated for difficult passages.
