Notes to the Conductor

Scottish Fiddle Medley is an arrangement of two memorable Scottish tunes—"The Waves of Tory" and "The Stronsay Wedding." This easy arrangement gives each section a chance to play the melody, so careful attention should be given to dynamics when the low strings have the melody. The tunes should be played with a connected detaché bow stroke. The eighth notes should be played with a slight "lilt" that is more than straight eighths but less than a full swing. Off-beat patterns will be more authentic if played at the frog. The more dance-like the pieces sounds, the more authentic the performance will be.
