Freely, as the wind blows

*Measure 1: Begin the Singing Bell (SB) in the bass bells, then add in the Random Ring (RR) in the treble chimes. Play measure 1 until the mood is established then move on to measure 2. (See performance notes for explanation of RR and SB).

Measure 2: The SB continues. The chimes stop the random ring but allow the sound to continue until it fades a bit. The windchimes play at the beginning of measure 2.

Director: These two measures are in a free tempo, however, avoid letting the energy “sag”. Some overlap of chime sound from measure 2 into measure 3 is fine.
