Maritime March is a "jaunty" British-style march opening up in the key of C natural minor (Aeolian mode). Sixteenth notes combined with simple syncopations highlight the second strain in a question-and-answer section that pits the woodwinds against the brass. The traditional trio moves to the key of Eb and features the low clarinets in unison with the French horns. This is a very appealing march that will be easy to put together and really make your young band shine.
