PROGRAM NOTES

Salvation is Created was written in 1912 by Russian composer, conductor, and teacher Pavel Tschesnokoff (1877–1944). Written basically in ABAB form, this piece was one of the last sacred choral works Tschnesnokoff wrote before being compelled towards secular music by the Soviet Union.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

One of the most enduring and beautiful chorales ever written, this arrangement of *Salvation is Created* has been scored for beginning band. The tempo is marked at mm=80, which is slightly faster than the original work. As your ensemble becomes confident with the piece, you may wish to vary the tempi and dynamic levels.

As in performing most chorales and chorale-like works, the most important things to reinforce with your band are always maintaining a good sound throughout, listening to each other, and keeping a proper balance and blending between the parts. You may need to adjust the dynamic levels in some places to adjust to your ensemble's instrumentation.

I hope you and your ensemble find Salvation is Created to be an exciting and worthwhile musical experience!
