## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Composed by jazz cornetist Nat Adderley and recorded with brother alto saxophonist Julian "Cannonball" Adderley, *Work Song* has become a staple of the jazz repertoire. The Adderley version was recorded in a call-and-response style in that they alternated playing the melody every two measures. This arrangement has been written with a similar call-and-response in mind in that the trumpet and alto have the option of playing the melody in its entirety together or in the same style as the Nat and Cannonball version.

The groove should be a strong shuffle-swing style with heavy emphasis on the swing and not too much on the shuffle back-beat. Be careful the tempo doesn't go too fast as the swing eighth notes will begin to even out which will lose the swing effect. In keeping with the call-and-response concept, the interplay between sections (brass and saxes) also continues with alternating sections on the second chorus in measures 25–40.

At measure 57, the interplay between sections continues instead of the typical sax soli and shout chorus. This seems more appropriate as this tune has traditionally been considered a small-group composition. Regarding articulation, note that the *marcato* or rooftop accents are played detached, think "daht."

The chord progression for the solo section in measures 41–56 is the basic progression of the tune and not the chord changes used in the melody section which are slightly more complex. All students should be encouraged to learn to improvise on this classic tune. The solo section can be opened up for additional solos if desired. Nat and Cannonball (deceased) Adderley are true jazz legends and are important figures for students to know. I suggest you check out the original recording and also the demo track which is available at [alfred.com](http://alfred.com).

I hope you and your students enjoy playing *Work Song*.
